Sarnath Bishop Suffragan of Beverley the lawful Commissary of William Dalrymple by Divine Providence Lord Archbishop of York Primate of England and Metropolitan in compliance with the said Petition do hereby consecrate the piece of land as a Burial Ground for the said Parishes of Terrington with Wiggancliffe and Santhorpe and declare it by this Our Definitive Sentence to be consecrated accordingly And we hereby order the Seal of the Consistory Court of York to be hereunto affixed and this Sentence to be registered in the Registry of the Diocese of York Dated at Terrington aforesaid this twelfth day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seven.
