

This Indenture made the twenty seventh day of November One thousand nine hundred and five Between the Right Honourable George James Earl of Carlisle of the one part and the Parish Council of Gerrington with Wiggonthorpe and the Chairman and Overseers of the Parish Meeting of Ganthorpe both in the County of York (hereinafter called the grantees) of the other part Whereas the Earl of Carlisle is seized in fee simple of the piece of land hereinafter described and has agreed with the grantees to convey to them the said piece of land for the purposes of a Burial ground Now this Indenture witnesseth that in consideration of the premises and pursuant to the provisions of the Burial Acts 1852 to 1900 and of the Local Government Act 1894 the Earl of Carlisle "as Settlor" hereby conveys to the grantees All that piece or parcel of land containing one acre or thereabouts situate in the parish of Gerrington in the County of York and having a frontage of seven hundred and forty five links towards the North East on Mowthorpe Lane and bounded on the West by land belonging to William Martin and on the South West by other land belonging to the Earl of Carlisle and which piece of land is more particularly delineated or shown on the plan drawn on these Presents and therein surrounded with a blue verge line to hold the same unto and to the use of the grantees their successors and assigns for ever for the purposes of a Burial ground for the said parishes of Gerrington with Wiggonthorpe and Ganthorpe according to the true intent and meaning of the said Acts In witness whereof the parties
